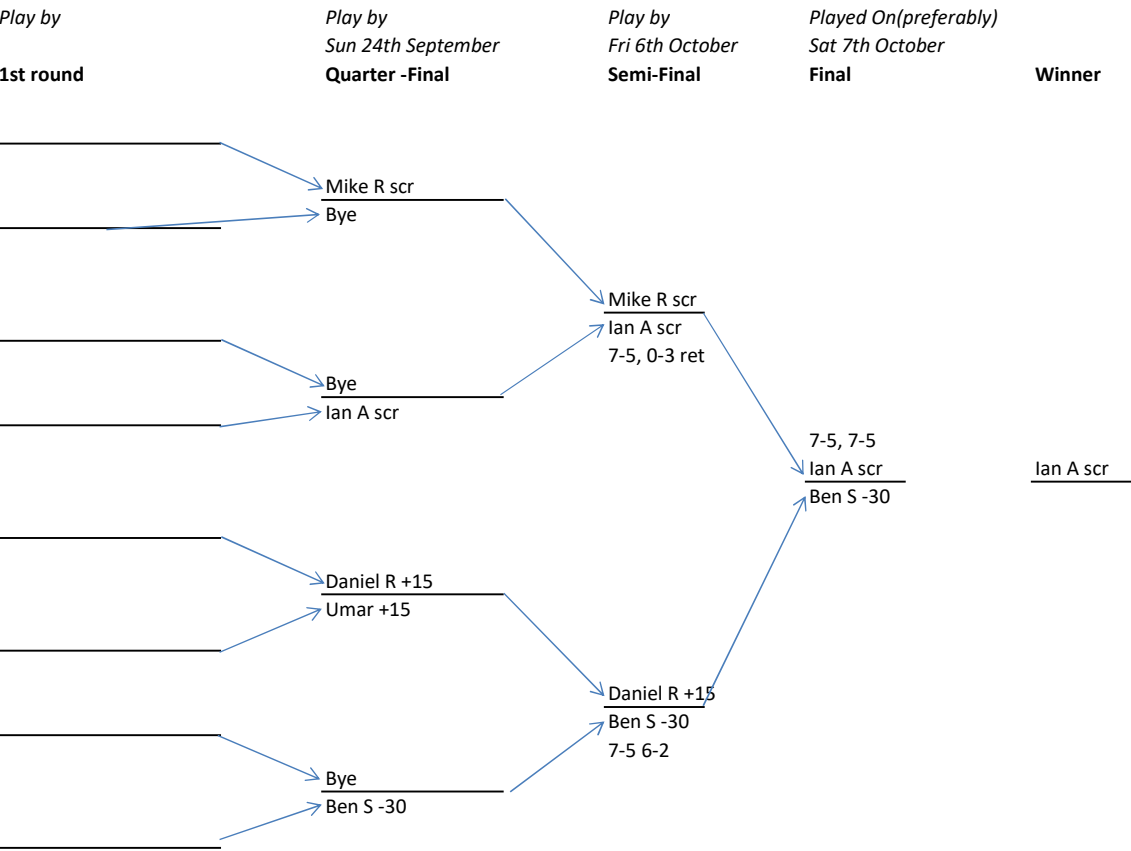


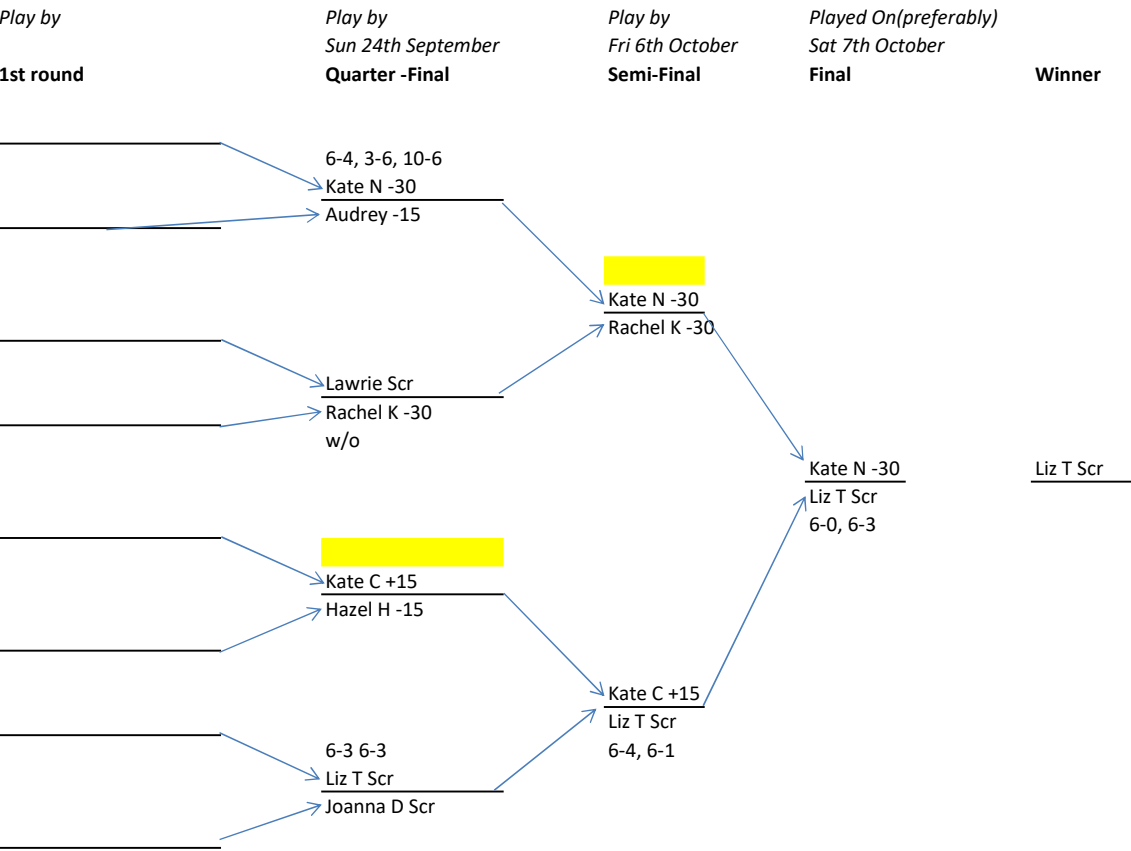
MENS HANDICAP SINGLES

Format: Best of 3 sets with the 3rd set being a match tie break to 10.
Set Tie breaks to 7 - you start with positive or negative 1 point for each handicap point difference.
Match tie breaks to 10 - you start with positive or negative 2 points for each handicap point difference.
Please net down handicaps if possible, ie. Two -30 players would both play off scratch against each other



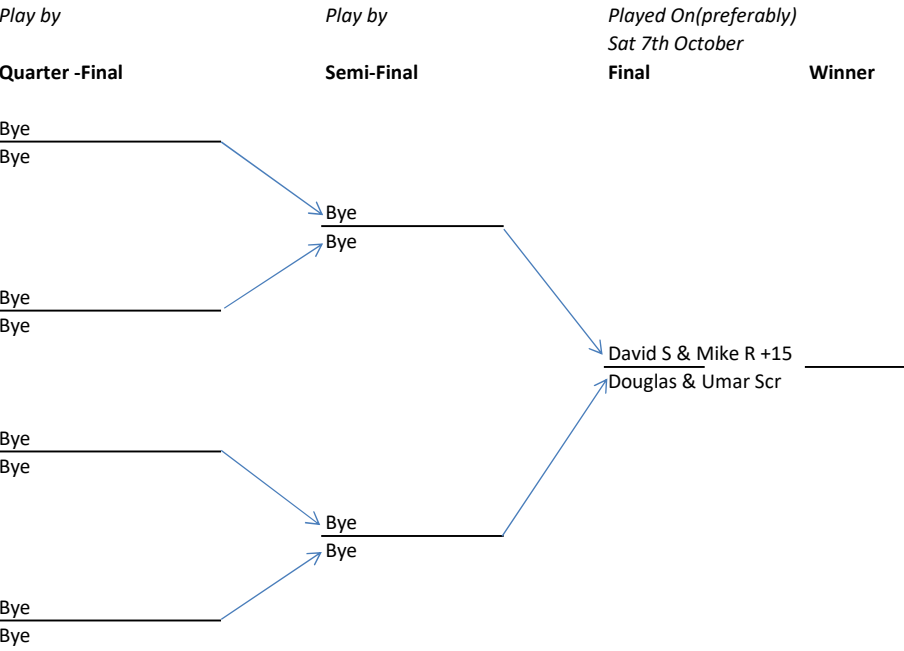
LADIES HANDICAP SINGLES

Please net down handicaps if possible, ie. Two -30 players would both play off scratch against each other



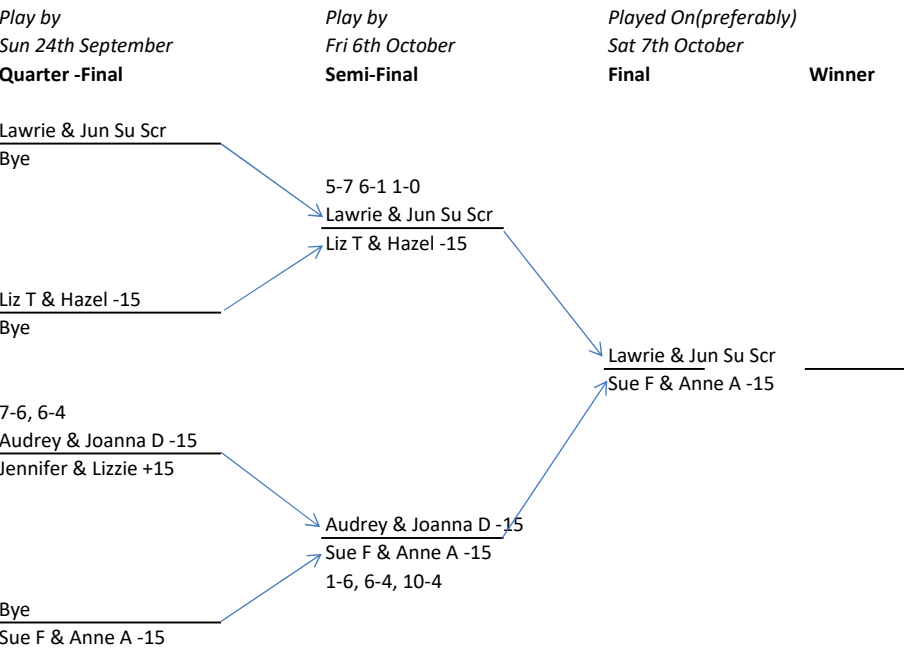
